

THE 3-STORY-TALL 5G TOWERS ARE BACK!

Boldyn Networks, a private company, is planning 32' tall 5G cellular towers at the southwest corner of Horatio and Washington and the northwest corner of West 12th and Washington. On the left is a NY Times photo of one such tower. On the right is a scale mock-up of the tower on Horatio Street. Note the size of the tower relative to the people standing beneath it:



The rationale for these towers is they will provide broadband access to underserved communities. However, every building in our area is already wired for broadband.

The State Historic Preservation Office (SHPO) has determined these huge, futuristic towers will have a negative impact on the adjoining Greenwich Village and Gansevoort Market Historic Districts. Boldyn Networks is asking SHPO to reverse this decision. Tell SHPO to stand firm and demand the towers not be sited at these locations.
